

Eyelet Lace Shawl[®] in Moods

Easy

Materials:

3 balls Moods, 50% Wool, 50% Acrylic, 197 yds per 100 g.
US 11 size needle (29" circular recommended)
Crochet hook

Abbreviations:

Yo – Yarnover

K – Knit

St(s) – Stitch(es)

K2tog – Knit 2 Sts together

M1 – Make a stitch by lifting the strand of yarn between the stitch on the left needle and the stitch on the right needle from front to back, knit into the back of the stitch.

Method:

Cast On 5 stitches.

Row 1: K1, M1, knit across row to last st, M1, K1.(7 sts)

Rows 2 and 4: Knit all sts. (garter stitch)

Row 3: K1, M1, knit across row to last st, M1, K1. (9 sts)

Row 5: K1, M1, knit across row to last st, M1, K1. (11 sts)

Row 6: K1, (Yo, K2tog) repeat to end, K1

Repeat rows 1 through 6 until shawl measures 30 inches from tip to needle.

Knit 3 rows of garter stitch and bind off loosely.

Finishing:

Knit, Relax, Smile, Repeat!

Attach fringe by folding double strands of yarn 13” in length, draw the loop through the stitches at the edge of the shawl with a crochet hook. Pull the ends through the loop. Tighten. Weave in all ends.

Knit, Relax, Smile, Repeat!
